A selection from the new FLO-WERS series will also be on display: In 2022, Helzle began experimenting with flowers as part of the photographic condensations. At the beginning of 2023, the time had come and the first pictures of the FLOWER series were created,

photographically illuminated from different perspectives.

## "HEAVEN ON EARTH" IN THE CITY LIBRARY REUTLINGEN

Opening: 6. 9. 2024 19:00 and then until 16. 11. 2024

Masayuki Akamatsu and Wolf Nkole Helzle got to know and appreciate each other at the Ogaki Biennale in Japan in 2004. In the 20 years since then, they have had many joint projects and exhibitions, both in Japan and in Europe.

To mark their 20th anniversary, the two media artists are showing their latest works.

In his work cycle "Thales' Engraving", Akamatsu traces the orbits of the stars and Helzle layers images from his travel diary in his work cycle "SIMULTANEITIES". (See left column for description).

The work "Thales Engraving" by Masayuki Akamatsu is a collection of photographs and videos of the starry sky taken with special equipment. It looks like a star trail, i.e. the movement of the stars, but the image is formed not only by the stars but also by the movement of the earth and the recording equipment.
